

- a. Homicide or great bodily injury resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle.
- b. Commission of a felony in which a motor vehicle is used.
- c. Failure to stop or render aid as required by state law in the event of motor vehicle accident resulting in death or personal injury or serious property damage.
- d. Perjury or the making of false affidavit or false statement or certificate to the Department of Transportation.
- e. Operation of a motor vehicle without having furnished proof of financial responsibility when proof of financial responsibility is required.
- f. Operation of a motor vehicle after revocation or suspension.
- g. Violation of license restriction.
- h. Knowingly flee or attempt to flee or elude an officer.
