On February 26th The Lady Eagles played Christian Life I for the first game of the tournament. This game, with the **Spirit Stick** in tow, showcased just how much this team has grown during the season taking the win 27:13. Scoring for the Eagles: Ally Smith who tied her season high of 12 points, Lori Bakke - 5 points, Shelby Jacobs - 4 points (with an AWESOME assist), Cheyenne Pofahl - 2 points, Alley Crawley - 2 points, and Amber Fisk - 2 points. Defensively great job by all but especially by Tyler Krause - you go girl! This win broke yet another record by our Lady Eagles - 1st ever in tournament play.

On February 27th this game marked a rematch against Trinity Racine. The first quarter we stunned Trinity by providing competitive game play both offensively and defensively. The score at the end of the first quarter was 4:5. By the second quarter we were down by 8 points. During the third quarter Trinity overpowered us, and by the end of the fourth quarter Trinity took the win 18:32. Scoring for the Eagles: Shelby Jacobs - 8 points, Ally Smith - 4 points, Lori Bakke - 4 points, Brittany Smith - 2 points. Though this was a frustrating loss, it was another great lesson for the Eagles. It takes a great offensive and defensive effort for all four quarters to take the win.

Sunday, February 28th marked our final game and a chance to take 3rd place from this tournament. This was our first time meeting up with St. Sebastian, and our Lady Eagles came out playing aggressively. Though this was felt like a great loss losing 12:21, our Lady Eagles did a fantastic job. Scoring for the Eagles: Lori Bakke - 5 points, Ally Smith - 3 points, Cheyenne Pofahl - 2 points, and Amber Fisk - 2 points. Defensively all of our Lady Eagles played well during this game with Cheyenne stepping up when needed - nice job Cheyenne!

You have made me proud to watch just how much each of you has taken from this season. Eyes were big seeing the tournament trophies on display this past weekend, and hopes were dashed in the end.
