From the Desk of *Pastor Conradt* Normalcy

There were so many things that we had to adapt to over the last year. Catchy phrases were adopted all over like "these unprecedented times" and "the new normal". There is no doubt that people's lives have been affected in many ways. The Lord in His wisdom has chosen to call some of our loved ones to Himself. This has happened according to His timing. God is still in control and we need to be thankful for that. We need to rejoice in the time that He has given us here to love and serve Him, and love and serve our neighbor: to proclaim the message of His Son.

The time has come to move forward. The time has come to rejoice in the gifts of our church family: the brothers and sisters that He has blessed us with here in the household of faith.

I don't want things to go back to "normal". Because "normal" wasn't very godly. It didn't properly reflect God's will for the lives of His children. "Normal" for the Christian doesn't look like sporadic worship attendance, lack of reading and studying God's Word, failure to pray, praise, and give thanks. It doesn't look like family units disjointed and neglected.

God gave us an opportunity to cleanse the "normal" that became our lives and return to what it should have been; what it had gotten away from.

More people were home with their children. Many events we have allowed to get in the way of devotion to the things of God were cancelled. Sports (all levels) were cast down from the idol place that they held in the hearts of countless people. Parent and child were given the

opportunity to eat together, to worship together, to find time in God's Word together. All the false gods that got in the way were cast down; but unfortunately, not for long enough.

Now that more things begin to pick back up around us let us not lose sight of the gift that we have been given. The fact that God, in His providence, sends or allows for things to cause His people to repent and return. As we walk through fiery trials let us grow stronger in the faith. Let us grow stronger as a family unit both in our individual households and in this household of our Father.

If you are physically able, come to church each week to receive Christ's gifts of Word and Sacrament. Spend each day in His Word and prayer. Use Luther's Small Catechism as it was intended: as a tool for prayer. Purchase a hymnal and sing the great hymns that have been handed down to us for centuries and even millennia in your homes and in these walls.

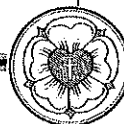

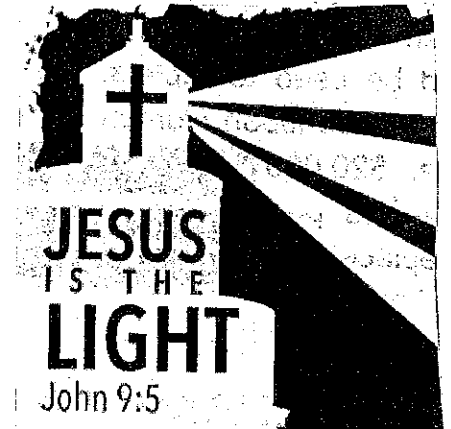
