From the Desk of Pastor Couradt Expanding Catechesis: Logic Level

If you haven't already, I would encourage you to review the last two newsletters to read more about the need for expanding catechesis. The next two newsletters will be looking at the remaining expanded levels.

The levels once again are Catechesis: Grammar Level, Catechesis: Logic Level, and Catechesis: Rhetoric Level. These levels follow the classical education model. Grammar gives us the basic building blocks, Logic helps us think through these things critically, and Rhetoric gives us the ability to defend and speak persuasively.

The new Catechesis II: Logic program is mostly an expansion of our previous two year program to a three year program which includes:

- *Year I: Old Testament Catechesis
- *Year II: New Testament Catechesis
- *Year III: Lutheran Catechesis

All of these materials are available through Concordia Catechetical Academy of Peace Lutheran Church—Sussex, Wisconsin, and are provided by St. Peter's.

This will better equip the children of our congregation to be disciples for life and have a deeper foundation in the Scriptures and Lutheran doctrine.

Also included in this level will be ways for families to serve in the church *e.g.* assisting with Sunday School, fall clean up, Altar Guild for girls, ushering for boys, etc. With the new core group of acolytes, this position is no longer required of our confirmands.

Our hope is to get the catechumens and their parents involved in ways that they can continue to serve Christ's Church in the future. Whether they remain in the area or move away, there is a great need for catechized people everywhere. Raising up girls to be godly wives and mothers; and raising up boys to be godly husbands and fathers.

This program eligibility begins in 6th grade, but may be started later. Completion of Catechesis: Grammar Level is not required to enter Catechesis: Logic Level, but learning the 10 Commandments, Apostles' Creed and Lord's Prayer by heart prior to entry is strongly encouraged.

The manual for this program is available on the church website for viewing under the tab: Catechesis.

"In the second place, after they have learned the text well, teach them the meaning also, so that they know what it means.... Take your time in doing this. For it is not necessary for you to explain all the parts at once, but one after the other. After they understand the First Commandment well, then explain the Second, and so on. Otherwise they will be overwhelmed, so that they will not be able to remember anything well" (SC Preface 14-16).
