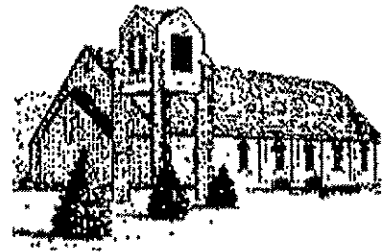

From the Desk of Pastor Conradt

Thank you!

Children of God: Thank you. In July you pulled off an incredible surprise. 10 years ago I publicly swore, "[To] perform the duties of [my] office in accordance with these [Lutheran] Confessions, and that all [my] preaching and teaching and [my] administration of the Sacraments will be in conformity with Holy Scripture and with these Confessions." And to, "instruct both young and old in the chief articles of Christian doctrine... to forgive the sins of those who repent, and never divulge the sins confessed to [me]. To minister faithfully to the sick and dying, and demonstrate to the Church a constant and ready ministry centered in the Gospel. [To] admonish and encourage the people to a lively confidence in Christ and in holy living." To "Honor and adorn the Office of the Holy Ministry with a holy life. To be diligent in the study of Holy Scripture and the Confessions. And [to] be constant in prayer for those under my pastoral care."

In turn this congregation swore, "to honor and uphold your pastor as he serves Christ in all his God-pleasing responsibilities. To aid him as he cares for his family. To be diligent to 'put the best construction on everything,' recognizing that 'love covers a multitude of sins.'" (Agenda Ordination/Installation of the Pastor). We promised to do these things with the help of God.

As your pastor I strive to follow the Table of Duties laid out for me in the Small Catechism: I Timothy 3:2-6 and Titus 1:9; and I ask that you strive to follow yours as well: I Corinthians 9:14, Galatians 6:6-7, I Timothy 5:17-18, I Thessalonians 5:12-13, & Hebrews 13:17. As an imperfect man when I have failed, please forgive me.

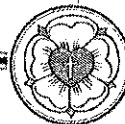

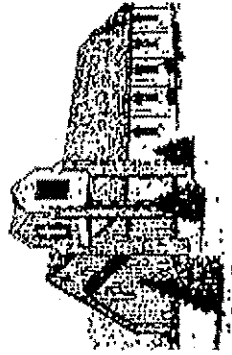

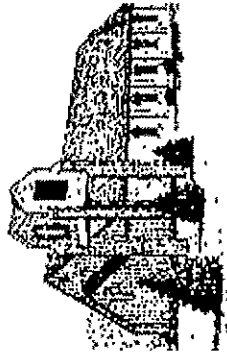
