#### From the Desk of Pastor Couradt

#### Advent & Christmas

It's that time of year! The new Church Year has begun. We are excited to once again offer Advent Midweek Vespers services this year on four Wednesdays. This provides the congregation with two separate opportunities to worship each week, which will continue throughout the year, with the Divine Service being celebrated outside of Advent and Lent.

Advent is a time of preparation. Much like Lent it is a time for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. The hymnody is beautiful, with a few of the hymns being sung by the Church for well over 1,000 years.

While Advent prepares us for Christmas, it also focuses us on our Lord's final coming. We look forward to Judgment Day as we will be caught up with those that have preceded us in the faith to live with Him for eternity.

Advent gives way to the celebration of our Lord's birth. The Feast of the Nativity of Our Lord is the second highest feast of the Church Year. The mood is festive and these hymns beautifully proclaim our Lord. Worship service times include Christmas Eve: 5:00 & 7:00 PM and Christmas Day: 9:00 AM. This year we are pleased to see the return of a choir which will assist us Christmas Eve. A huge thank you to our God-gifted organist Daniel Grosskreuz for adding this to his duties.

Please remember that Christmas is a 12 day celebration that begins at sunset on December 24th. We will continue our celebration on Sunday January 1st with Divine Service at 9:00 AM. This day we celebrate the Circumcision and Name of Jesus to fulfill the law on our behalf. (There is no service Wednesday December 28th).

After the 12 days, the Epiphany season begins, marked with a special service on Friday January 6th. It is this day that we celebrate the Wisemen finding the King of all creation and giving Him gifts. This is very much a celebration of Christmas for us gentiles. As such, Epiphany is an extension of Christmas. So while your Christmas tree and decorations belong up until at least January 6th, there is also a tradition of leaving them up through the season of Epiphany.

So many get caught up in the world's rushing to X-mas from a retail point of view, that they tire of it by the time the Church begins its celebration. Don't let the world dictate how to celebrate the birth of our Lord. There is a proper time and season for all things in the Church and that should govern our lives far more than the world. Take this month to breath, slow down, and pray; then get caught up in the joy when we celebrate Him. Continue that celebration well into January and sing with the Church the beautiful hymns of joy in the birth of our Savior.


