### From the Desk of Pastor Couradt

### Vicarage

It's been thirty years since our church received her first vicar. Vicar Rick Twenhafel (1) served this congregation under Pastor Bischoff's tutelage from 1992-1993. He is now serving as Pastor of St. Paul Ev. Lutheran Church in Duluth, Kansas. St. Peter had a total of 20 vicars. Out of those 20, 18 are serving in the ministry.

Currently, former vicars serve as pastors all over the country. This includes Oklahoma, Michigan, Texas, Iowa, Colorado, Alabama, and Oregon. There are two in Illinois, two in Minnesota, and two in Kansas. One has two earned doctorates and is a professor at Concordia University, Irvine, California. There are four serving in Wisconsin. One in the North Wisconsin District and three in our own district. That includes Rev. Gary Tillman (7), Rev. Roger Erdman (16), and yours truly (19).

Of those men that continued their studies here Rev. Curtis (11) serves as the head of Stewardship for the Synod and is married to Rev. Jack Gilbert's sister Rebekah. Rev. Gilbert serves St. John, Racine and just filled in here on a Wednesday in January. While at Symposia at the Fort Wayne seminary in January, I met Rev. Jay Watson (2) and also saw Rev. Adrian Sherrill (8)'s daughter Joanna (the oldest of twelve), who is in the hallway picture with Dad and Mom when she was a baby. She now had her first child with her.

Needless to say, our church has done a lot to help prepare men for the ministry and the impact can widely be seen. In November, our congregation voted to return to this program after a 10 year hiatus. Some of you were here for all twenty vicars while others are newer to the congregation. As we get everything ready to make this happen, here are a few things that are helpful to know:

In order to become a pastor in The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod a man must have a bachelor's degree and typically attends an additional four-year program of seminary instruction. This includes two years at the seminary (either St. Louis or Ft. Wayne), followed by a year of on site internship under the care of a pastor (which we call vicarage). He then returns to the seminary for his fourth year of learning, at the end of which he earns a Master of Divinity (M. Div.).

There are things that a vicar can and cannot do. He preaches sermons approved by the pastor, conducts parts of the liturgy, teaches Bible studies, assists with the preschool, accompanies the pastor on visits, and attends meetings. He does not administer the sacraments-including with the homebound-nor does he conduct weddings or funerals.

This program requires a substantial financial commitment. Please let us know if you would like to help. We are looking forward to being an instrument of the Holy Spirit to help raise up these men to be pastors that will preach Christ crucified to a world in need of that eternal message.

The church ended 2022 with a surplus of \$51,484. It is a blessing when we end the year with a surplus as we did last year. There are large expenses that arise which are not covered by the normal operating budget. Examples include replacing the roof shingles every 25 – 30 years, repairing or replacing old heating equipment when needed, etc. Surplus dollars go into savings for this type of uses when needed.






